Rationale This topic has been chosen so that children can gain an understanding of what is meant by the past and present. We are using the theme of 'shops' so children can share their personal experiences and how these will be different from those of parents and grandparents.

Enalish

In English, we will be using the book 'The Growing Story' to sequence key events so that we can retell the story. We will be focussing on using our phonic skills to build words and sentences, using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Children will also have daily 'Read Write Inc' phonic sessions where they will learn a new sound each day. They will practice reading these sounds in words whilst consolidating sounds already learnt.



PSHE / Thrive

In these sessions children will identify different types of feelings. They will discuss when they may feel this way and explore how to manage these feelings. We will also look at changes that happen and discuss how loss can make us feel.

Computing

<u>Art</u>

Children will be taught the importance of using technology safely. This half term they will be focussing on their keyboard

Children will explore the work of artist Albert Durer. They will be introduced to a range of drawing tools, such as charcoal, pencil, chalk and pastel.

Children will learn about different mechanisms. They will investigate how sliders work. They will design and make their own card slider product.

Music
